Honors Thesis Application Form

Certification of Eligibility to Enroll in PS or CJ 4510:

- 1. All GJS honors students must complete and turn in this form with their thesis prospectus to the GJS Honors Program Director within the first week of the semester in which they want the credit registered.
- 2. Please submit a 1-2 page thesis prospectus in addition to this form. **Any thesis application forms turned in without the prospectus will be returned.**
- 3. To submit the thesis application, email it and your prospectus to Dr. Williams (williamsmr4@appstate.edu) and CC your thesis advisor and second reader. They will each reply to the email chain indicating their approval in lieu of signatures.
- 4. Note that honors students will need to complete a <u>Special Course Form</u> for each semester they plan to receive academic credit for the thesis and thesis preparation.

Once you've filled out everything except the signatures, please send it in an email with the following parties included: your thesis advisor, Dr. Williams (williamsmr4@appstate.edu), Ms. Novak (novakse@appstate.edu), Dr. Marcum (marcumcm@appstate.edu), and CAS (casshforms@appstate.edu). Your advisor and Dr. Marcum will reply with their approval and then the registrar will create the course for you.

- 5. Completing the thesis does not guarantee graduation with honors. Students must complete (6) hours of honors coursework with a B or better in each course, successfully complete the thesis preparation, and meet the major GPA requirement to graduate with honors in political science or criminal justice.
- 6. A signed copy of the thesis must be emailed to the Honors Program Director by the last day of regular classes in the semester in which the thesis is completed (see "Prepare Your Thesis" document located at http://gjs.appstate.edu/academics/honors-program)
- 7. If pursuing both University and Departmental Honors, the second reader must be from a different department than the Thesis Director.
